	<ul> <li>Consultations and how they are carried out. GBG noted that since</li> </ul>	
	2021 GC has stopped including a list of respondents in its	
	consultation responses and GBG has specially asked for the	
	respondents to the recent Regulatory Returns consultation	
	AR wants to talk about communications with operators.	
	• The Forum will be an opportunity for GC and trade to discuss	
	confidential policy and data matters as well and so there needs to	
	be clarity about what can /can't be publicly communicated

	the elements in the DCMS Summer land-based consultation	
	coming into force by 1 <sup>st</sup> October whilst Cashless, will have a later	
	implementation date of April 2025.
