Presentation by Gary Davies (HMRC) – National Minimum Wage (NMW)	
within the Betting and Gaming Sector	
PH introduced Gary Davies from HMRC who discussed the NMW within the Betting and Gaming Sector	
GD stated that HMRC will be carrying out Compliance checks for the Gambling sector within the next few weeks and stressed that it's not just about pay rates – the key issues and pitfalls relate to the employment calculations.	
Typical areas of failure in relation to NMW include:	
<ul> <li>Unpaid working time (eg opening the AGC a few minutes early, staying on to empty machines etc)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Rounding up (eg a person arrives a few minutes after their 9am start time but they only get paid from 9.15am)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Training – (unpaid training time, especially if staff asked to complete e learning at home)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Deductions – (eg reduced price staff meals which is deducted from pay)</li> </ul>	
HMRC will look back at 6 years and fines for non-compliance are 200% of	
the NMW underspend and the company will be publicly named.
